

Regulations of Use of the Educational Trails and Weather Stations

§1 General provisions

- 1. The Regulations define the rules for the use by children and adults of the educational trails and weather stations "Środowisko Wiedza i Alternatywne Technologie (ŚWiAT) [Environment, Knowledge and Alternative Technologies] Local Centre of Weather Stations and Natural Science Knowledge, managed by the Starostwo Powiatowe w Gnieźnie [Gniezno County Office] (Governing Authority).
- 2. The rules set out herein are intended to ensure full safety for people staying on the premises.
- 3. The Governing Authority shall not be responsible for personal belongings and other items left behind on the educational trails and in the weather station.

§2 Rules of use

- 1. All children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- The meteorological devices located on the premises may only be used/operated by authorised persons; Visitors are not allowed to open the covers or doors of the meteorological instruments.
- 3. The water well hatch may only be opened by authorised persons.
- 4. The teachers, guardians and parents shall be responsible for the safety of children/pupils/students during their stay in the premises.
- 5. Any noticed irregularities should be immediately reported to the Governing Authority and the Maintenance Staff.
- 6. The teachers/guardians shall be obliged to inform children about the applicable safety regulations and to require their observance.
- 7. Under no circumstances should children be left unattended on the premises.
- 8. It is allowed to conduct lessons/classes on the premises; additional equipment, if necessary, may be brought in for this purpose.
- 9. In the event of an accident, medical assistance should be provided to the injured child, then the Governing Authority and the child's parents/guardians should be notified.

- 10. The educational trails and the weather have been equipped with 24/7 security cameras for day/night monitoring and recording.
- 11. The processing of personal data in video surveillance system is necessary for the purposes arising from legitimate interests pursued by the Governing Authority, i.e. ensuring security and protection of property.
- 12. The data controller is the Governing Authority.
- 13. On the premises it is forbidden to:
 - a. climb roofs, wooden structures and equipment,
 - b. open the water well hatch,
 - c. disassemble of weather equipment or devices and open the doors of the weather station,
 - d. litter on the premises,
 - e. light bonfires and use open flames,
 - f. play football and other team games
 - g. drink alcohol, smoking cigarettes and using other drugs,
 - h. use the premises after dark.
- 14. Dogs or other animals are not allowed on the premises.
- 15. Cyclists must park their bicycles in designated spots (bicycle racks).
